

It is the policy of the City of Hudson to plant trees and to encourage monetary donations for the purpose of planting memorial, remembrance, recognition or celebration trees in public spaces such as the Green and Green Extension, areas around City buildings, parks and cemeteries.

The current cost of planting a **2-inch diameter shade or flowering tree** will be **\$300** which will include marker, tree, and labor to plant. A 2-inch diameter tree will range from 5-8 feet in height.

Note: Pricing for evergreen trees or larger diameter trees will be consulted with the Arborist.
It is the discretion of the Arborist to determine when the tree will be planted.

The donation equals the cost of buying and planting the tree, and the donation will be listed and kept at the Hudson Library and Historical Society's Tree Donation Archive Book.

Consideration will be given by the City Arborist for requested type of tree for a specific location. The City has a Master Tree Planting Plan.
